#### **Easter Egg Trail - 15 April to 26 April**

A special Easter Egg Trail set in the grounds of the Hall from 15 to 26 April. Once the trail is complete, join us for Brunch in the Hall served from 10am-11am including an Eggstra Royal Breakfast. Also serving breakfast from 8am-10am for those who want to get an early start on the trail. Adults £15; Children £7.50. Guests not wishing to dine at the Hall but still wishing to complete the trail, an entrance fee of £5 per child will apply.

**Easter Sunday 21 April** - Lunch served in the Orangery between 12.00 and 3.00pm with a menu created from locally sourced, seasonal ingredients. 3 course lunch with treats for all - £32 per adult; £22 per child. Easter Afternoon Tea served between 12.00 and 3.00pm - £28 per adult; £14 per child under 12.

Saturday and Sunday lunch are available every weekend and Royal Afternoon Tea is served daily.

**Father's Day Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June** – 3 Course Lunch £29.00 per adult; £15 per child. Afternoon Tea - £28.00 per adult, £15 per child. Alternatively, Dad can swap traditional afternoon for a "Gentleman's Afternoon Tea" which includes sandwiches, pork pie, scotch egg, sausage roll, cheese with pickle and crackers and an individual trifle to finish off. Lunch or Afternoon Tea also includes entrance to the gardens and grounds with a fantastic display of cars including Bentleys, Rolls Royce and Lamborghini amongst others.
