Roadside refuse collection service

The black wheelie bins are for landfill refuse. For recycling there are blue bags for paper and cardboard and black plastic tubs for cans, tins, glass, bottles, plastic bottles etc. The brown lidded wheelie bins are for garden recycling items with collections only mid March to November. There is a charge of £39 pa by Harrogate Borough Council to have each brown lidded garden recycling bin emptied.

In **Goldsborough** the landfill wheelie bins and the garden recycling brown lidded bins are emptied fortnightly on Mondays with the blue bags and black boxes emptied on the previous Friday.

In **Flaxby** the landfill wheelie bins are emptied fortnightly on a Monday with the blue bags and black boxes emptied on the following Monday. The garden recycling brown lidded bins are emptied on alternate Fridays.

At Bank Holiday the collections may be brought forward or put back a working day. Bins need to be on the kerbside by 7.00am on collection day.
